

# Supplemental Activity Instructions

*Building Zaha: The Story of Architect Zaha Hadid*

This lesson's book showcases a watercolor artistic style portraying Zaha Hadid's life and accomplishments. Apart from being a renowned architect, Zaha Hadid was also an artist and designer. Participants of this activity will practice a skill many architects utilize in their daily practice – rendering/sketching.

1. Follow the instructions on the back of the Lesson Card.
2. After building is complete, participants shall begin to “render” their work the way architects showcase their designs.
3. Using any drawing medium (crayon, pencil, watercolor – preferred), participants are to view their project from a chose point of view and draw their designs as how they see it. Unique artistic styles of renderings are encouraged.
