







What is capX?



In a nutshell: The California Architectural Practice Experience (capX), developed by the California Architectural Foundation (CAF), is a statewide program designed to expand hands-on, practical experience in architecture firms. In its first year, capX will focus on supporting community college students but is open to everyone, including graduates seeking internships or employment opportunities.

The program fosters collaboration among architecture firms, emerging professionals, and educational institutions, creating a community dedicated to strengthening the architectural profession across California.
