# How to ask for Nomination Letter and What to Include



#### ∭ Introduce Your Request

Politely ask if your reference would be willing to write a letter for your scholarship application. Be sure to explain why you're applying and the significance of the scholarship to your goals.



#### **Highlight Specific Skills** and Achievements

Ask them to focus on specific academic or professional achievements that they have observed.

Suggest they mention any notable projects, awards, or leadership roles you've taken on, especially those that relate to the scholarship's focus.



### **Provide Examples of** <u>\_\_\_\_</u> ິງດີ Your Impact

Request that they include concrete examples of contributions you've made, whether in class, work, or volunteer activities.

Examples that demonstrate your ability to collaborate, innovate, or overcome challenges will be particularly impactful.



#### **Align with Scholarship** Goals

Ask them to emphasize how your aspirations align with the mission or values of the scholarship.

If relevant, mention how the scholarship could support your professional or academic development.



Encourage them to describe personal qualities that showcase your work ethic, resilience, creativity, or commitment to your field of study or community.

### Closing Endorsement

Politely request that they include a strong endorsement of you as a deserving candidate and provide their contact information in case follow-up is needed.



#### **Provide Necessary** Information

Offer any necessary details, such as the scholarship name, due date, and instructions for submission to make the process easier for them.



This is one of this first documents the jury reads, make sure it counts. Always ask more than one person for a letter, select the strongest to lead your submission.

People are busy and sometimes plans fall through, reach out early and always have a back up.
