SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Section 1: A one-page personal essay on one of the following prompts:

- What do you believe to be the most important design factors that promote health and healing?
- What motivates you in pursuing health care design?
 Personal experiences, social responsibility, etc.
- Describe any independent steps you've taken increase your knowledge or skill related to healthcare design.

Section 2: Biography and/or Resume

Section 3: One letter of support from an AIA member, a professor or an educator.

Section 4: A project portfolio. Healthcare projects are preferred, but not required.

- Minimum of 2 projects should be included in your portfolio and it should not exceed 8 pages.
- Include a brief narrative on each project.
- Identify health-promoting attributes and design strategies in non-healthcare projects
- Clearly designate your role in group projects. Learn more on AIA credit guidelines here.

Entry submissions are uploaded as a single PDF document in portrait orientation, 8 1/2 x 11 size. **Submission may not exceed 8MB.**

Proof of Enrollment: An official school statement, ID or class Schedule must also be provided. This is a separate PDF that is not part of the submission PDF.
