SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Page 1: Letter of Support on letterhead detailing personal and professional contributions. *Must be from an Educator or AIA Member. Must have 1, may include up to 3.*

Section 2: Resume

Section 3: Essay answering the following prompt:

- What motivates your pursuit of architecture, and how do you envision contributing to the profession? Discuss both the experiences that have shaped your interest and your goals for the future.
- **1-2pgs, 12pt font**

Section 4: Design Portfolio

- Minimum of 2 projects should be included in your portfolio and it should not exceed 8 pages.
- Include a brief narrative on each project.
- **Clearly designate your role in group projects.**

Entry submissions are uploaded as individual documents in portrait orientation, 8 1/2 x 11 size. Submission may not exceed 8MB.

Proof of Enrollment: An official school statement, ID or class schedule must also be provided. This will be requested if you are selected for the scholarship.
